## **Laptop - BYOX - Bring Your Own Device**

### As a guide for parents we have provided the following advice:

The student/parent/carer pays for the following equipment:

- 1) The device (including keyboard)
- 2) Antivirus software (free versions available)

Optional additional equipment:

- 3) A good carry case or protective sleeve (highly recommended)
- 4) Any specialised accessories or software (user's choice depending on senior subject selection)

#### The school (EQ) provides each student's device with:

- 1) Office 365 Suite of programs (Word, Excel, PowerPoint etc.)
- 2) An email account and program
- 3) BYOX Connect Service (connects to secure school network and internet and adjusts security setting for safe use of device (https://byox.eq.edu.au/byox-connect/Pages/default.aspx)
- 4) Access to learning portals (e.g. learning place)
- 5) Other teaching and learning resources and selected online content
- 6) Server and/or cloud storage

#### **Device Specification**

- Device can either be a laptop or a tablet (Tablet must have an external keyboard)
- Screen should not be less than 11"
- Processor should be at least an i3
- Operating memory should be 4GB (RAM) or greater
- Hard drive should be at least 128 GB
- Device must have WI-FI capabilities to connect to the school's internet
- Antivirus software
- Wireless mouse
