# Laptop Guide - BYOX - Bring Your Own Device

#### As a guide for parents, we have provided the following advice.

The student/parent/carer pays for, and responsible for the care of, the following equipment:

- 1) The device (including keyboard)
- 2) Antivirus software (free versions available)

#### Optional additional equipment:

- 3) A good carry case or protective sleeve (highly recommended).
- 4) Any specialised accessories or software (user's choice depending on senior subject selection)

## The school (EQ) provides each student's device with:

- 1) Office 365 Suite of programs (Word, Excel, PowerPoint etc.);
- 2) an email account and program;
- 3) BYOX Connect Service (connects to secure school network and internet and adjusts security setting for safe use of device (https://byox.eq.edu.au/byox-connect/Pages/default.aspx);
- 4) access to learning portals (e.g. The Learning Place);
- 5) other teaching and learning resources and selected online content; and
- 6) storage on secure cloud servers.

#### **Device Specification Recommendations:**

- Device can either be a laptop or a tablet (Tablets must have an external keyboard).
- The screen should not be less than 11".
- In considering the processor, it should be at least an i3.
- The operating memory should be 4GB (RAM) or greater.
- Hard drive should be at least 128 GB.
- The device must have WI-FI capabilities to connect to the school's internet.
- The device contains antivirus software.
- Consider the inclusion of a wireless mouse.
